- Double portal entrance
- Above the entrance is a large Rose Window

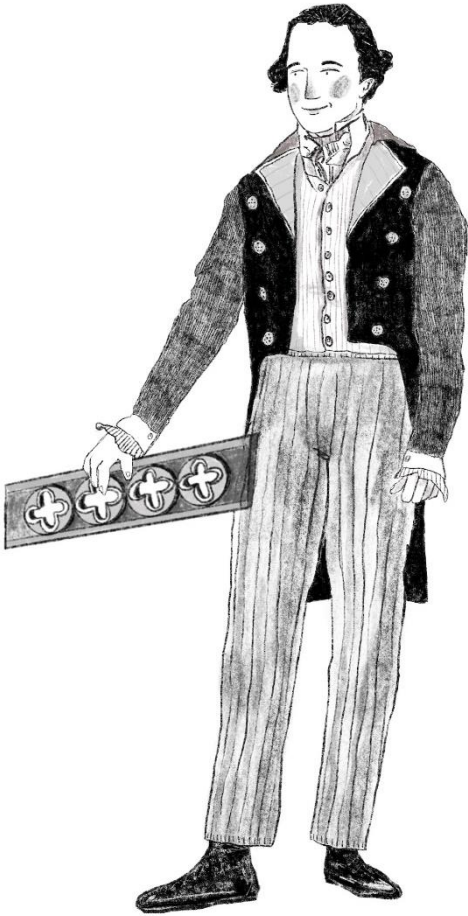

## Newry Courthouse

- Designed by Thomas Duff
- Opened in 1843
- Central granite entrance
- Beneath the tower is a pediment, triangular in shape
- The tower is also known as a cupola

*It is not quite finished, can you add a touch of colour to the Court House.*

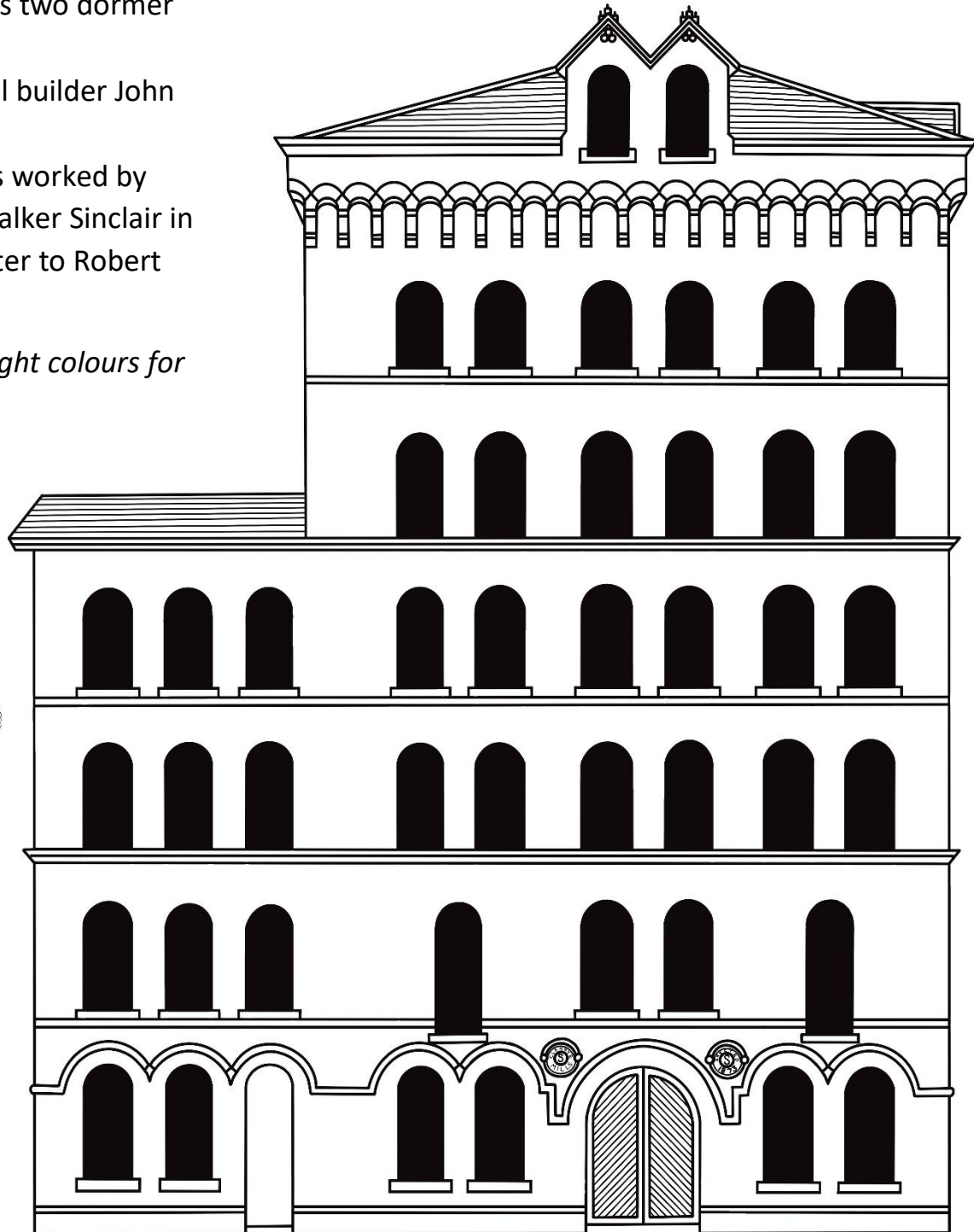


## Clanrye Mill or Sands Mill

- Designed by William Watson
- Built in 1873
- 6 Storeys tall
- Constructed in Belfast brick
- Top level has two dormer windows
- Built by local builder John O'Hare
- The mill was worked by Abraham Walker Sinclair in 1884 and later to Robert Sands

## The former Belfast Bank, Marcus Square

- Built in 1890
- Designed by William Watson
- Constructed by Alexander Wheelan a local builder
- High Victorian Gothic Revival
- Balconies throughout the building
- Turrets to the roof

## First Non-Subscribing Presbyterian Church

- Built in 1853
- Designed by W J Barre
